- A partnership program between the Fund, NYCHA and The Met.
- An educational experience that provides you with opportunities to:
 - Be active participants in your personal and professional development
 - Hear from arts, museum, and creative professionals about a range of careers
 - Engage in exciting and interactive opportunities
 - Develop professional skills, network, and gain work experience
 - Experience for creative exploration
 - Get to know what actually happens inside museums (museum literacy)

- Spend 40 hours in-person at one of the most globally renowned museums!
- Learn leadership development skills alongside peers and mentors
- Work with professionals from The Met and outside the Museum, learning from them and building your professional network
- Experience The Met's space and exhibitions
- Explore career pathways in the world of art, culture and museums, and build your resume
- Earn a \$1,100 stipend
- Create a community with other interns





MHAT MILL YOU DO?

- Meet 2-3 times per month to create an activity that you will lead during two Teen Programs at The Met
- The project will relate to using various art forms as a tool for social justice and activism - ARTivism
- You will guide that activism by exploring issues that matter to you
- With our guidance, you will take ownership over the development of the project
- At the end, we'll celebrate your work with a reception

STIPEND, SUPPORTS & REQUIRED PAPERWORK FOR ACCEPTED SCHOLARS



- Earn a \$1,100 stipend when completing the program
 - The stipend will be paid in two installments, \$500 late April 2024, and \$600 in June 2024.
